What's your style of photography?

I specialise in natural images, particularly outdoors in beautiful, soft light.

I'll capture your personalities and all the love and joy. I'll give you some guidance so that you look your absolute best, but I'll do this in a way that doesn't spoil the fun or kill the spontaneity.

Your time together as a family is really precious so it's important that we make the experience as *enjoyable* as possible and true to life (without the tantrums, if you have young kids!).



Do you have a photography studio?

No. My Inverness business address is a PO Box and not a studio.

I spend the bulk of my time on wedding photography, out on location, so it wouldn't make financial sense for me to invest in a studio.

Also, I'm not overly excited by studio photography as everyone's pictures end up looking the same!

I'd much rather photograph your family in a place that has special meaning for you. This approach appeals to me way more than being in a hot, stuffy studio with a boring white backdrop.

Don't worry if you're not sure about the best location for your photoshoot; I'll be happy to advise!







Will the photoshoot take place indoors or outdoors?

I LOVE working with natural light and beautiful scenery so prefer to be outdoors if at all possible. I think this also helps with capturing natural images (and fun ones, with the kids).

However, I'm also happy to work indoors, especially if you have a young baby or if the weather's poor.

If you live locally, we should, ideally, use a location that means something special to your family, such as a local beach or woodland. Your family is unique and I want to reflect this in my photography!

If you're visiting the area and need some suggestions, I can happily recommend some great locations. I know the Highlands like the back of my hand. Just let me know what type of scenery you'd like!

What will your approach be on the day?

Most importantly, your family photoshoot is going to be enjoyable!

I'm very down-to-earth and easy to get along with (and I'm great with kids), so we'll soon get to know each other, which will help everyone to relax in front of the camera.

I'll capture lots of photographs, with different combinations of people, in different settings, and I'll show you how to sit or stand so that the photos look very natural and not overly posed.

I'll also capture some completely candid shots. It's a great opportunity for me to take a step back and capture your family interacting as though I wasn't there.



Ideally we'll use more than one location so that there will be a good amount of variety in the images, but also because everyone will likely feel more comfortable around the camera as time goes on.



What if the weather's poor?

This is Scotland; the weather is the one thing that's beyond our control! Quite often, the weather forecast is only reliable a couple of days in advance (unless we're experiencing a long spell of settled weather, which doesn't happen often enough!).

I'm no stranger to being outdoors in poor weather. I photograph a lot of weddings and, naturally, these go ahead regardless of the conditions on the day. So, I can cope with whatever the weather throws at us and I'm happy to embrace the elements if you are.

However, I imagine you'll probably want some decent weather for an outdoor photoshoot! Ideally, I would like some nice weather too and avoid heavy rain, high winds or thick fog. Depending on the weather conditions, we might be able to go ahead but re-think our location, e.g. we'd want to avoid the beach on a windy day. Alternatively, we can work indoors in your home or holiday accommodation.

I'm open to rescheduling, providing I have availability (my calendar changes daily). The best approach is to keep me posted on your availability and aim to be flexible. Don't worry, you wouldn't be charged extra if we move the date due to the weather.

What if my kids misbehave?

In the run up to the photoshoot, please explain to your kids what's going to happen on the day, and perhaps promise them a treat if they behave! Also, let's plan the timings so that they're not going to get hungry five minutes into the photoshoot.

On the day, the best approach is to let me deal with the kids as much as possible (they behave better for strangers, right?). I know this is hard but it'll be more difficult for me to capture great images if you're angry and the kids are upset.

Also, if one of the kids doesn't want to do something, then let's not force them to. Tears, frowns and red faces are not a good look. Don't worry if someone has a meltdown! We can take a break then return to the photos once everyone's calmed down.

How will you hold the kids' attention?

I have a few tricks up my sleeve! For young kids, I have a cuddly toy which attaches to my camera lens, and a cute, mischievous puppet! If kids are reluctant to move from, say, the beach to the woods, I'll suggest something fun like a game of hide and seek!

Also, I'll try to keep the pace right. I'll not rattle through your photos too quickly (after all, I want to take my time to compose and light my shots to get the best results). However, I'll not go so slowly that it gets boring for anyone. Even if we do your photoshoot in one location, I'll add plenty of variety, in terms of backdrops, poses, combinations of people, etc. This will help to hold everyone's attention (adults and kids alike!).

If you feel really strongly about not being in the photos, then I won't force you into the pictures!

Think carefully though. Your kids won't care about the way you look but they, and you, will treasure these family photographs in years to come.

I'm hoping that the experience will be enjoyable enough that you'll soon forget about any insecurities.

Do you photograph events?

Yes, absolutely, apart from kids' birthday parties. I'm well suited to photographing events, given my background in wedding photography.

Typically, events involve more work, for various reasons. I may need to organise large numbers of group shots, and I often have less control over backgrounds and lighting, as things can sometimes unfold spontaneously. This means more preparation beforehand and more time spent in editing afterwards. As such, my event fees are higher than the fees outlined in this eBook.

Do you work with all-adult families and groups?

Do you travel?

Of course, you're welcome to travel to my neck of the woods; I can recommend lots of great locations for your photoshoot!



What will we discuss during the pre-shoot consultation?

Email works well for me (as I'm out and about so often) but I'm happy to have a 15-20 minute chat via phone or video call in advance of your session, if an optional pre-photoshoot consultation is included in your chosen photography package.

This will help me to find out more about you, and you can get to know me better too! We can discuss locations, clothing, any specific requests, etc.
