I specialise in natural images, particularly outdoors in beautiful, soft light.

I'll capture your personalities and the deep bond between you. I'll give you some guidance so that you look your absolute best, but I'll do this in a way that doesn't spoil the fun or kill the spontaneity.

Your time together is really precious so it's important that we make the experience as *enjoyable* as possible and true to life.

Do you have a photography studio?

No, I don't have a photography studio.

I spend the bulk of my time working on location, so it wouldn't make financial sense for me to invest in a studio.

Also, I'm not a huge fan of studio portraits as everyone's images end up looking the same!

I'd much rather photograph you in a place that has special meaning for you. Don't worry if you're not sure about the best location for your photoshoot; I'll be happy to advise!

If you'd prefer studio photographs, then I will happily redirect you to another photographer.







Where will the photoshoot take place?

I LOVE working with natural light and beautiful scenery, so prefer to be outdoors if at all possible. I think this also helps with capturing natural images. However, I'm also happy to work indoors, in your home or holiday accommodation, especially if the weather isn't great.

If you live locally, we should (ideally) use a location that means something special to you as a couple, such as a local beach or woodland.

If you're visiting the area and need some suggestions, I can happily recommend some great locations. I know the Highlands like the back of my hand. Just let me know what type of scenery you'd like!





What will your approach be on the day?

Most importantly, your photoshoot is going to be enjoyable!

I'm very down-to-earth and easy to get along with, so we'll soon get to know each other, which will help you to relax in front of the camera.

I'll capture lots of photographs, in different settings, and I'll show you how to sit or stand so that the photos look very natural and not overly posed.

I'll also capture some completely candid shots. It's a great opportunity for me to take a step back and capture you interacting as though I wasn't there!


What if the weather's poor?

This is Scotland; the weather is the one thing that's beyond our control! Heavy rain, high winds or thick fog would put a stop to an outdoor photoshoot.

Depending on the weather conditions, we might be able to go ahead but have to re-think our location, e.g. we'd want to avoid the beach on a windy day and move further inland instead. Alternatively, we can work indoors in your home or holiday accommodation.

For an outdoor session, I suggest that we arrange a preferred date but be open to the idea of rescheduling in the event of a particularly bad weather forecast. Don't worry, you wouldn't be charged extra if we move the date due to the weather.

I should mention that, quite often, the weather forecast is only reliable a couple of days in advance (unless we're experiencing a long spell of settled weather). The best approach is to keep me posted on your availability and aim to be flexible.



What time of day is best?

I'm much more concerned about the weather conditions than the time of day.

I've no problem with photographing in the middle of the day, when the sun is high in the sky. However, if it is a sunny day, I'll be seeking some shade (for, at least, part of your photoshoot) in order to find some soft, flattering light.

Please note that, ideally, I would like to do your photoshoot during traditional working hours.

Again, the best approach is to keep me posted on your availability and aim to be flexible.

If planning a photoshoot during the winter months, please be mindful of the shorter daylight hours (see <u>here</u> for further details).





Are you available all year round?

Yes, I work all year round (but please don't ask me to work on Christmas Day or New Year's Day!). If you're booking a photoshoot during the low season, we might need to be a bit more mindful of the temperatures, and the conditions underfoot. Also, we might need to be more selective about which location(s) we use, as some places can look a little bit bare in winter.

Please come prepared whatever the weather, whatever time of year. For instance, spring might be sunny but it can still be really cold, especially in the shade, and I've seen some people who are not adequately wrapped up against the cold. I'll bring mats to sit on and reusable handwarmers to hold, but they're no substitute for a warm coat and gloves!

The session and the end result - the photographs - will be better if everyone is dressed appropriately.





"My husband and I are from Pennsylvania and we travelled to Scotland to celebrate our ten year wedding anniversary! Karen helpfully suggested some locations in Inverness for our couple's photoshoot. 


Do you do black and white photography?

I love using colour in my images but I also appreciate black and white photography. I'll convert some of your images to monochrome where I feel it's most effective.







We don't want to pose. Can we just have fun?!

Yes! Typically, I blend traditional, naturally posed images (nothing too formal) with more fun, candid shots. However, we can, of course, keep your session completely natural! Please let me know in advance if you'd like your photoshoot to be 100% 'documentary', so I can plan for this scenario.

Do you travel, or hike to remote locations?

I'm based on the Black Isle so I do most of my work in the Inverness area. If you want to do your proposal further afield, then we can discuss an additional fee to cover my travel.

I love hiking and hill walking. However, if you're planning on proposing somewhere remote, please be aware that I would need to charge you extra for time spent hiking and lugging 15kg of camera gear around!



Do you photograph events?

Yes, absolutely. I'm well suited to photographing events, given my background in wedding photography.

Typically, events involve more work, for various reasons. I may need to organise large numbers of group shots, and I often have less control over backgrounds and lighting, as things can sometimes unfold spontaneously. This means more preparation beforehand and more time spent in editing afterwards. As such, my event fees may be higher than the fees outlined in this eBook.

If you're interested in booking an event, such as a formal gathering for a milestone anniversary, please <u>contact me</u> for a quote, and provide as much information as possible when you get in touch.



How will we communicate?

I want you to *feel* like you're my only client, but the reality is there are *lots* of other people on my books! This means I have to be very organised with my communication. Email works best for me, as I can set up a dedicated folder for your photoshoot, and you'll receive my out-of-office reply if I'm away from my desk.

Self-employment can often feel all-consuming, and 'switching off' is an ongoing challenge for me! After your initial contact form, please stick to email until the final run up to your photoshoot, when I'll give you my WhatsApp number in case we need to communicate on the day. Please download WhatsApp to be prepared for this scenario. Please revert back to email after your photoshoot.

I'll aim to respond promptly but please remember that I'm often out at photoshoots, particularly during peak season, and I'm striving to enjoy evenings and the occasional day off away from my inbox!

Can you explain the package system further?

You're busy. I'm busy. I like to keep things as simple and as efficient as possible!

Some photographers take a session fee then ask their clients to choose their images afterwards. I avoid this system for several reasons! You probably don't want to be faced with a gallery of unedited images and have the hassle of deciding which ones to purchase; in fact, you might never get around to it. Equally, I wouldn't want to be kept waiting for payment long after having completed a photoshoot.

The package system serves me and my clients well. I'll handpick your best images, showcasing different backgrounds and poses from throughout the photoshoot (I say 'poses' but think of it more as 'gentle direction'). We'll likely only need to exchange a handful of emails and, as soon as I've completed your editing, all you need to do is download the images!



Do you sell products?

I offer a range of products, including branded USB drives, a range of beautifully hand-crafted albums, and wall art. Please note that additional fees would apply for overseas shipping and that I'm unable to ship wall art overseas. The photography packages include digital images only, for a couple of reasons. Firstly, a large percentage of my clients come from overseas; digital-only photography packages helps to keep things simple. Secondly, if you decide to purchase products, I want you to have free rein in your decision-making and not be tied to a particular size of album or frame.

Do you sell gift vouchers?

Yes, I sell gift vouchers, which are valid for two years from the date of purchase.


When you purchase a gift voucher, I will provide you with the following:

- An eBook similar to this one, but with the package prices removed, ready for you to email to the recipient.
- An e-voucher showing the recipient's name, the photography package, and the voucher expiry date.

If you would like to purchase a paper copy of the gift voucher, a £10 surcharge will be applied, to cover postage and packaging, and my trip to the post office.

What happens after the photoshoot?

I'll individually edit all of your photographs to a high standard. After all, I'm a perfectionist! Your images will be ready within a maximum of five weeks. Normally it'll be *much* quicker. However, please appreciate that peak season gets *extremely* busy (and I'm only human).

Your photographs will be presented in an online gallery (which you're welcome to share with family and friends). You'll also receive links to download the digital images, with high resolution files ready for printing, and low resolution files ready for you to share on social media (if you wish).

How do we book?

Please note that bookings are taken on a first come, first served basis. My diary changes daily and I'm unable to offer date savers. To secure your photoshoot, I'll need you to complete an online booking form and make payment (a flexible payment option is available for the Deluxe Package, if needed).

Your photoshoot date will only be secure once payment has been made and the booking form has been completed. Please don't put it off! My calendar fills up quickly, particularly in summer and autumn/fall.
